

What is domestic battery of the 1st degree?

The definition of domestic battery of the 1st degree is relatively simple: it occurs when a person commits battery against a victim with whom he or she has a domestic relationship, and the battery results in "substantial bodily harm."

What is a second degree battery?

§34.1. Second degree battery A. Second degree battery is a battery when the offender intentionally inflicts serious bodily injury; however, this provision shall not apply to a medical provider who has obtained the consent of a patient. What is a first-degree battery charge?

In other words, the offender should have an intention to frighten the other person, and that can be enough for an assault charge. First-degree battery brings a sentence from five to forty years to life. You may be charged with first-degree battery if you do any of the following:

What is a third-degree battery?

This degree of batter brings a sentence of up to one year in jail. Third-degree battery considers cases when a person purposely causes physical injury to another person. Also, if the accused person recklessly causes physical injury to another person, it is considered a third-degree battery.

What are the consequences of a domestic battery 1st degree charge?
