

What is a battery model number?

The battery model number provides essential information about the battery's specifications, compatible laptop models, and the type of battery technology used. Knowing the battery model number ensures that you purchase the correct replacement battery.

How do I identify my laptop battery part number?

Here are some steps you can take to identify your laptop battery part number and fit models. The first step is to locate the battery label. This label is typically located on the bottom of the laptop or inside the battery compartment. The label contains important information about the battery, including its part number.

How to find HP laptop battery model number?

Locate the "P/N" prefix and record the number following the prefix. After that gently replace the casing and install screw and tell this model number to the manufacturer or the technician, they will then give the relevant battery for your laptop.

How do I find the model number of my battery?

For this, locate the battery compartment usually, it is near the hinge of the screen. Pull the button on the battery and remove the battery gently from the container. The white or silver rectangular sticker will be wither on the battery or inside the compartment. Note the number that follows the P/N prefix. It is your model number of the battery.

How do I find a battery number?

Internal batteries are often 6 characters long, adding 'XL' at the end (e.g. CM03XL). This is the best number to use in your search. There are also part numbers and spare numbers, always with 6 digits-hyphen-3 digits. Both are good search terms.

What is the model number of a 6-digit HP battery?

The model number of a 6-digit HP battery is a part number. For Sony batteries, the part number should start with VGP-BPS or VGP-BPL and contain 2 to 5 combinations of characters. Examples include vgp-bps35, vgp-bps35a, and VGP-BPS13Q.
