

Why is there no battery detected on Windows 10?

The "No battery detected" problem may arise due to corrupted battery drivers. You can attempt to resolve this issue by restarting or reinstalling the battery drivers. Step 1: Press the Windows key +R to open the Command Prompt. Type "devmgmt. msc" and press "OK" to open the Device Manager.

How do I fix no battery is detected on Windows 11?

Restart your PC after that to allow Windows to install the removed driver again. At times, issues with your PC's BIOS can also lead to the "No battery is detected" message on Windows 11. To fix it, you can try resetting the BIOS to its default settings. Step 1: Press the Windows key +S to open the search menu.

Why is my laptop battery not detected?
