

How many volts does a battery charge?

Depending upon ambient temperature, charging voltage generally varies between 14.8 and 13.5 volts. The actual charging voltage designed into a voltage regulator is dependent upon factors such as how far the alternator is located from the battery and the ambient air temperature surrounding the battery as calculated by the PCM.

How much voltage does a car battery generate?

The charging system in most cars will generally produce a voltage between 13.5 and 14.4 volts while the engine is running. It has to generate more voltage than the battery's rated voltage to overcome the internal resistance of the battery.

Why does a battery need a higher voltage than a rated voltage?

It has to generate more voltage than the battery's rated voltage to overcome the internal resistance of the battery. This may seem strange, but the current needed to recharge the battery would not flow at all if the charging system's output voltage was the same as the battery voltage.

How many volts should an alternator charge?

The actual charging voltage designed into a voltage regulator is dependent upon factors such as how far the alternator is located from the battery and the ambient air temperature surrounding the battery as calculated by the PCM. Under normal operating conditions, an alternator should maintain about 14.2 volts at 70°F; F ambient air temperature.

What volts should a car battery be plugged in?

Worst source of charging system I.R. drop is those "cut and install" battery terminal ends. On making sure all connections are clean and tight, including a good engine ground (and also the back-of-engine-to-firewall ground strap) before attempting any regulator adjustments. Anything between 13.8 volts and 15 volts is safe.

I see yours is going up to 15 / 15.1 v on your sg. Did you measure it at the battery/alt as well? Curious how high it is actually going / is it indicating slightly less on the sg? I wonder if 14.8 actual is enough to kick them off, that might not work so well for me. OP: how long are your plugs staying on? Do you monitor the voltage? Any chance ...

Check if it is a BMW OEM battery, if not it has likely been replaced prior to your purchasing and if the battery

is aftermarket it isn't able to be registered to the vehicle. Registering the battery replacement in the vehicles software is done ...

So 14.8v shortly after starting means that the battery is probably fully charged already and the voltage should then drop to around 13.6-14 fairly quickly. If the battery seems ...

A higher voltage means energy is being driven into the battery at a higher rate. 14.8 volts would be appropriate for a battery with less than an almost full charge and/or high electrical load. If the battery is at or very near full charge, it is appropriate for the charging voltage to be lower and that could explain the low 13 something voltage you observed.

The completely charged voltage should be $4 \times 4.2 = 16.8\text{v}$ for a 4S lipo. If you're not going to be using it for a few weeks, I'd leave it where you have it and try to completely charge it before you'll actually use it. The 3.7v/cell based voltage is called the "nominal" voltage like 1.2v/cell is called the voltage for AA cells. It ...

That's because the battery is full. A small amount of current will quickly raise the voltage to 14.8 volts, at which point the PWM charger quickly stops charging. Then the voltage of the battery drops immediately to ...

If the battery is good and strong you should see 13.8 - 14.8 volts (system voltage) for a while; it may then ramp down to the 13s and stay there depending on electrical loads. A fully charged "12 volt" battery will show 12.6 volts when disconnected from anything for a half hour. Anything below 12.6 is either a bad battery or something wrong with the charging system.

With the engine off, the fully charged car battery voltage will measure 12.6 volts. This is known as "resting voltage." When the engine is running, battery voltage will typically rise to 13.5 to 14.5 volts. The battery is boosted to these higher levels by the alternator.

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Part 3. What is the charged voltage of an AGM battery? The charged voltage of an AGM battery is the voltage it reaches when it's fully charged. It's the maximum voltage the battery can hold. This voltage is typically around 14.4 to 14.8 volts. It's important to note that the charged voltage can vary slightly depending on the battery's ...

If the battery state of charge (SOC) is high, the PCM will target a voltage about .5V over battery voltage (typically around 13.2V)--so just a little current is pushed into the battery (so it doesn't overcharge). If your
