What is the LCOE of China's photovoltaic projects?

China Photovoltaic Industry Association recently releases an analysis on the LCOE (Levelized Cost of Electricity) of China's photovoltaic projects. According to the report: In 2019, the average annual utilization hours of photovoltaics nationwide were 1169 hours, and the construction cost of photovoltaic power plants is $\$4.5/W$.

How much will solar power cost in China?

At present, China's distributed PV is still in its infancy. With the improvement of solar power technology, the cost of solar power will be reduced continuously. Based on the learning curve of PV module prices, it can forecast that the price of PV modules will be 1.45 $\$/W$ by 2015 and 1.00 $\$/W$ by 2020.

How to promote solar PV installation in China?

Since 2009, the Chinese government has taken a series of measures to promote solar PV installation in China. In March 2009, the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development initiated the first national PV program to subsidize BIPV systems larger than 50 kWp with 0.2 RMB/Wp (equivalent to 0.12-0.20 RMB/kWh).

Why is China developing distributed solar photovoltaics?

Development of distributed solar photovoltaics mainly benefited from the incentive policies in China. Currently the cost of PV power generation is still higher than traditional energy sources. China's PV industry is incapable of competing in the energy market without policy intervention.

How much will PV electricity cost in China by 2015?

According to our analysis, if electricity prices of the provinces remain unchanged, the cost of PV electricity could be reduced to 0.52-1.22 RMB/kWh by 2015, which is comparable with the grid prices in regions with large PV capacity and high electricity prices, such as Guangdong, Beijing, and Shanghai.

Why is China's PV (photovoltaic) industry overcapacity?

Since the 21st century, as the rising industry for national strategy, the China's PV (photovoltaic) industry has been developing rapidly. Its capacity and production rank to the world's No.1. However, the lag of domestic PV market development diametrically results in the overcapacity.
