

How big is photovoltaic power generation in China?

According to data released by the National Energy Administration, the cumulative total installed capacity of photovoltaic power generation in China in 2020 was 253GW, a year-on-year increase of 23.8%. As photovoltaics gradually enter the era of parity and 14-five-year plan, the installed capacity will show a more rapid growth trend.

How can China reduce the cost of photovoltaic power generation?

Continuously enhancing the conversion efficiency of photovoltaic cells is an effective measure to reduce the overall cost of photovoltaic power generation, he said. China added 216.88 GW of new PV capacity in 2023, up 148.12 percent from 2022, when the country added 87.41 GW of solar.

Why is photovoltaic power important in China?

In recent years, China's distributed photovoltaic power generated by households has developed rapidly, the NEA said, adding that this has played a vital role in ensuring the safe and reliable supply of electricity, promoting the green transformation of energy as well as driving the growth of farmers' incomes.

How big is China's photovoltaic capacity in 2020?

In 2020, China's newly installed grid-connected photovoltaic capacity reached 48.2GW, a year-on-year increase of 60.1%, of which the installed capacity of centralized photovoltaic power plants was 32.7GW, a year-on-year increase of 82.68%; the installed capacity of distributed photovoltaic power plants was 15.5GW, a year-on-year increase of 27.04%.

How will China's photovoltaic industry grow in 2019?

As photovoltaics gradually enter the era of parity and 14-five-year plan, the installed capacity will show a more rapid growth trend. According to the incomplete statistics of CPIA, 16 enterprises in China's photovoltaic industry completed 18 financing projects in 2019, with a corresponding financing scale of 36.27 billion yuan.

What is China's new PV installed capacity?

In the first three quarters of 2020, China's newly added PV installed capacity was 18.7GW, higher than the level of the same period of last year. In the fourth quarter, it showed explosive growth, making the annual newly added installed capacity reach 48.2GW, including 32.68GW of centralized PV and 15.52GW of distributed PV.

China started research on solar cells in 1958, which were first applied on the satellite Dongfanghong no. 2 in 1971. The first terrestrial application was in 1973 (the 15 Wp solar-powered navigation light in Tianjin Harbor). The photovoltaic industry has the opportunity to develop rapidly in China, and its solar power capacity already accounted for 35% of the world's total in 2020. However, solar power generation had only reached 3.4% of total power generation and 10.7% of renewable energy power generation by 2020 (China Electricity Council 2021).
