The two solar consortiums that dropped out of Romania are a German subsidiary of Longi Green Energy Technology, one of the world's largest makers of photovoltaic cells and solar panels, and two European subsidiaries of the Chinese state-backed power company Shanghai Electric.

Why did China withdraw from the EU?

But the China Chamber of Commerce to the EU slammed the rules "as a tool of economic coercion" which left the Chinese companies with "no commercially prudent options but to withdraw". The CCCEU claimed the Chinese companies faced more scrutiny than other non-EU firms,and said the withdrawal "hampers" the EU's "green transformation efforts".
