

How to replace auxiliary battery?

We open the car door and pull up the floor covering to find the auxiliary battery. Once the floor cover is removed, we will find the battery under the cover plastics. Disassemble the locking pins of the battery terminals, then, remove it from the dedicated compartment and replace it with a new one (same voltage).

How do I remove the auxiliary battery?

Locate the cabin air filter housing on the left of the engine bay. Remove the plastic bolt that holds the cabin air filter in place, then lift the cabin air filter housing to access the auxiliary battery. FIRST, remove the NEGATIVE battery terminal using a 10 mm socket. Then, remove the POSITIVE battery terminal.

Do I need to remove Fender to replace aux battery?

1st off you don't need to remove the fender to replace the AUXs battery, that is the hard way. All that needs to be done is remove a couple clips at the bottom of the plastic liner, lift up on the lines and remove the bolts holding the Aux battery in. In 5 minutes the Aux battery is out.

How to replace a battery?

Once the floor cover is removed, we will find the battery under the cover plastics. Disassemble the locking pins of the battery terminals, then, remove it from the dedicated compartment and replace it with a new one (same voltage). After connecting the battery terminals, we cover it with the cover and then with the floor covering.

How long does it take to replace an aux battery?

All that needs to be done is remove a couple clips at the bottom of the plastic liner, lift up on the lines and remove the bolts holding the Aux battery in. In 5 minutes the Aux battery is out. If a dealer is taking your fender off to get to the Aux battery then you should go elsewhere for service because they are incompetent.

How do I remove a bad aux?

If you're going to completely remove the AUX I suppose you can leave both terminals connected to the main as long as you isolate and wrap the connections on the AUX side. Or you can just remove the entire harness. If you leave the bad AUX where it is, just disconnect the negative. You'll want to pull the fuse in both instances.

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The auxiliary battery is located under the cabin air filter housing. Locate the cabin air filter housing on the left of the engine bay. Remove the plastic bolt that holds the cabin air filter in place, then lift the cabin air filter housing to access the auxiliary battery.

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Open the hood and remove the airbox connector to service the batteries. To remove the airbox, refer to the picture below for the screw / bolts needed (each one is circled in yellow). The airbox cover might be 8MM and not 10MM, I can't remember. The PCR that needs to be unplugged is circled in red. If you have small hands or a really talented you might be able to ...

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There have been a lot of discussions about what is the easiest way to replace the Auxiliary battery. Some prefer to remove the fender and/or fender liner vs just going in from the top. The rivets along the outer edge of the fender are where removing the fender liner gets tricky. I opted to just go in from the top. I have watched a

lot of videos and read a lot of posts ...

The early videos showed the easiest way was to remove right front tire and fender. But I kept watching videos and found one showing you only needed to remove the right front tire and fender liner, without removing the entire fender. Then someone commented that you didn't need to remove the tire just turn it full lock. Then another comment said ...

If you want to remove the battery - then remove it, and wrap up the cables where you removed the battery and leave them where they are. Just insulate them or make sure that they can't touch anything else.
