

How to remove the battery panel of the heating coaster

Do you need ducting on a Toyota Coaster motorhome?

The plan in our Toyota Coaster motorhome is to have overhead cupboards all the way around the edge and this is the perfect place to put them. We also decided on a roof mounted split system air conditioner,so we did not require ducting from the front. These were frustrating to remove.

How do you hold the walls on a Toyota Coaster?

The walls in the Toyota Coaster are held on with metal screws on the padded edges,and trim fasteners on the walls. I started the hard way with the trim fasteners - trying to remove one by one. This was not a fun endeavor.

What is a duct in a Toyota Coaster motorhome?
