# How to unplug the power cord of a small battery pack

How do I connect a power pack to a battery?

Unplug the Power Pack from its Adapter before connecting its cables to a battery. Connect and disconnect battery cable clamps only after setting any JumpStarter switches to OFF position. Connect cables to proper polarities. Connect black cable to negative body ground and red cable to positive battery terminal.

### How do I charge a power pack?

Refer to Charging the Power Pack on page 7. Plug the 12 V Port Adapter into the 12 VDC Output Port on the side of the Power Pack. Plug the appliance into the 12 V Port Adapter. Turn on the appliance. When finished using, turn off and unplug the appliance. Recharge the Power Pack. Verify Power Pack is fully charged and recharge as needed.

### How do I unplug the Power Pack?

Plug the device into the USB Port. When finished, unplug the device from the USB Port. Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician. Unplug the Power Pack, turn the Power Switch off and allow Power Pack to cool completely before performing any inspection, maintenance, or cleaning procedures.

### How do I use a power pack?

Plug the supplied USB Cable (or the device USB cable) into the USB Output Port on the side of the Power Pack. Plug the appropriate connector on the USB Cable into the device. Press and hold the Main Power Buttonabout one second to turn on the Power Pack. Turn device on,if necessary. When finished using,unplug the device from the USB Cable.

#### How do I charge a 120 volt power pack?

Plug the 120VAC Adapter into a 2 or 3-prong outlet. Slide the Adapter socket onto the 120VAC Charging Input Plug on the back of the Power Pack. The Charging Indicator lights will illuminate in a cycle from red, to yellow, to green while the unit is charging. The green Charging Indicator light will remain on after charging is complete.

#### How do you maintain a power pack?

TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY FROM ACCIDENTAL OPERATION: Turn Power Switch to its "off" position, unplug the Power Pack, and allow it to cool completely before performing any inspection, maintenance, or cleaning procedures. BEFORE EACH USE, inspect the general condition of the Power Pack.

Once you have confirmed the model, choose a battery pack compatible with your power recliner to avoid wasting money. If you purchase an incompatible battery pack, you might waste your money.
