

How to save your phone's battery?

Your phone's battery can last longer and perform better if you avoid extreme temperatures, charge smartly, use battery saver mode, and update your software. In addition, you can monitor battery health for any issues, turn off connectivity options you don't need, and use a power bank to avoid draining it completely.

How does a phone battery work?

A battery is, essentially, a sort of chemical energy that is reignited each time you place your phone on charge. The electricity powers the separate parts of the battery (the current, anode, and cathode) and is transferred from one end to the other to recharge your phone. Ultimately, a battery's job is to keep your phone on and alive.

How do I keep my phone battery healthy?

Avoid full charge cycles (0-100%) and overnight charging. Instead, top up your phone more regularly with partial charges. Limiting your smartphone's maximum charge to 80-90% is better for the battery's health than topping up to completely full everytime. Use fast charging and wireless charging technologies sparingly and when your device is cool.
