

# How to use wireless charging of battery pack video

How does wireless charging work?

Wireless charging requires two specially designed coils of wire -- one in the charger, and one in the device you want to charge. When you power up the charger, it sends a current through its coil, which, when placed in close proximity to a device, will induce an electric current its own internal coil. This powers up your phone.

How do I charge my phone wirelessly?

Most modern smartphones, smartwatches, and other electronic devices come with built-in wireless charging capabilities. If your device does not have this feature, you may require a wireless charging receiver or case that is compatible with your specific device. Positioning: Place your device on the wireless charging pad or dock of the power bank.

How do I charge my wireless power bank?

Initiate charging: Once your device is properly positioned, the wireless power bank will start charging it automatically. You should see a charging indication on your device's screen or through any charging indicator lights on the power bank. Leave it to charge: Allow your device to charge wirelessly for the desired amount of time.

How do I use my power bank if my device doesn't support wireless charging?

Charging with a cable: If your device does not support wireless charging, you can still use the power bank by connecting it to your device with a compatible charging cable. Simply plug one end of the cable into the power bank's USB port and the other end into your device's charging port.

Can a wireless charger charge a phone without a cable?

Not at all. All the compatible phones can still be charged with their included cables if you don't own a wireless charger or don't have access to one at that moment. And if you do use a cable and the proper adapter your phone came with, chances are it'll charge much quicker than it would wirelessly. What kinds of wireless chargers can you buy?
