

Is it legal to install solar panels on the roof

Can you install solar panels on your roof?

Homes and businesses will be able to install rooftop solar panels more easily, under new rules announced today. Changes to permitted development rights rules will mean more homeowners and businesses will be able to install solar panels on their roofs without going through the planning system.

Do I need planning permission to install roof panels?

There are a few conditions that apply if the requirement for planning permission is to be avoided. Panels must not be installed above the ridgeline of the property and should not protrude more than 200mm from the surface of your roof.

Do I need to comply with building regulations for solar panels?

there is already a ground mounted system within the curtilage of the building. As with any other structural alteration to a property, the installation of solar panels will require to comply with Building Regulations and evidence of this compliance would need to be presented to the local authority.

Can solar panels be installed without a planning system?

Changes to permitted development rights rules will mean more homeowners and businesses will be able to install solar panels on their roofs without going through the planning system. Currently those who have to go through the planning system are having to wait over eight weeks and face extra costs.

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels?

The solar panels must not be visible from the road if you live in a conservation area or world heritage site. If the property is a listed building, planning permission will most likely be required. Any additional ground-mounted solar installations beyond the first one will also require planning permission.

Should solar equipment be mounted on a roof?

If the property is situated on a World Heritage Site or conservation area, solar equipment should not be mounted on a roof that forms the front face of the building or the side of the building visible from a public road. If your property is a listed building, you should consult your local planning officer.

Do I need permission to install panels?
