

# Ranking of battery export companies in the Republic of Congo

What is Congo's most valuable export product?

From the more granular four-digit Harmonized Tariff System code level, refined copper and unwrought alloys represent the Democratic Republic of the Congo's most valuable exported product representing 61% of the country's total export sales by value.

How much does Congo export in 2022?

That percentage and relatively limited range of goods indicates Congo's highly concentrated portfolio of export products. Given the Republic of the Congo's population of 4.92 million people, its total \$11.1 billion in 2022 exports translates to roughly \$2,300 for every resident in the Central African country.

How much do Congolese exports cost in 2023?

Located in Central Africa, the Democratic Republic of the Congo shipped US\$28.5 billion worth of exported products around the world in 2023. That dollar amount results from a 113.1% acceleration from \$13.4 billion 5 years earlier in 2019. Year over year, the value of Congolese exports declined by -2.9% compared to \$29.4 billion starting from 2022.

Why does the Republic of the Congo export a stronger US dollar?

Consequently, the Republic of the Congo's weaker local currency makes its exports paid for in stronger US dollars relatively less expensive for international buyers. The Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) could become a major low-cost and low-emission producer of lithium-ion (Li-ion) battery precursors, says research company BloombergNEF in a report, but the country must move beyond the simple export of raw materials. The market for battery energy storage is estimated to grow to \$10.84bn in 2026.

Democratic Republic of the Congo has a high level of specialization in Cobalt (492), Cobalt Oxides and Hydroxides (356), Refined Copper (142), Raw Copper (65.5), and Tin Ores (54.7). Specialization is measured using RCA, an index that takes the ratio between Democratic Republic of the Congo observed and expected exports in each product.
