

Slovenia industrial energy storage plan announced

What is the Slovenian energy policy?

The purpose of the measure is to accelerate the deployment of investments in renewable energy production and energy storage, with the aim to foster the transition to a net-zero economy. The Commission found that the Slovenian scheme is in line with the conditions set out in the Temporary Crisis and Transition Framework.

What are the major developments in the renewables sector in Slovenia?

The main developments in the renewables sector include the introduction of the National Energy and Climate Plan and the adoption of secondary legislation, aiming to make Slovenia a climate-neutral society in the coming decades and motivating private finance to invest in projects including renewable sources.

What does EU state aid mean for Slovenia?

European commission. The European Commission (EC) on Friday approved, under EU state aid rules, a EUR-150-million (USD 161m) scheme in Slovenia that aims to support the expansion of renewable energy, heat and energy storage.

What does the European Commission's EUR150 million scheme mean for Slovenia?

The European Commission has approved a EUR150 million Slovenian scheme to support the rollout of renewable energy and heat as well as energy storage, in line with the Green Deal Industrial Plan.

Is the Slovenian scheme in line with the temporary crisis & Transition framework?

The Commission found that the Slovenian scheme is in line with the conditions set out in the Temporary Crisis and Transition Framework. In particular, the aid (i) will be granted on the basis of a scheme with an estimated capacity volume and budget; and (ii) will be granted no later than 31 December 2025.

Does Slovenia have gas storage facilities?

Slovenia does not have gas storage facilities, with companies dependent on infrastructure in Austria and Croatia. Slovenia has expressed interest in securing U.S. LNG sources via terminals in Krk, Croatia, or Rovigo, Italy, to diversify its supply away from Russia.

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November 14, 2019: Slovenia has become the first country in the Balkans to install a grid-scale battery storage unit in what is Tesla Energy's largest installation in Europe, Tesla said on October 17.

Slovenia state-owned utility Dravske elektrarne Maribor (DEM) is planning two battery storage units totalling 60MW co-located with an existing hydroelectric unit, as well as a new pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) plant.

On November 25, 2024, LPO announced a conditional commitment of up to \$289.7 million to Sunwealth to help finance Project Polo, a deployment of up to 1,000 solar photovoltaic (PV) systems and battery energy storage systems (BESS).

By 2035, the company plans to build renewable energy power plants with a capacity of 1,751 MW and flexibility facilities with a capacity of 800 MW. The power plants operated by Holding Slovenske Elektrarne (HSE) generated 6,581 GWh of electricity in 2023. The amount is 10% above the plan and 30% higher than in 2022, according to HSE Group's ...

HSE, or Holding Slovenske Elektrarne, aims to have 175MW of flexibility resources online by 2030 before nearly quadrupling that number by 2035. The 800MW will be made up of 590MW of pumped hydro energy storage (PHES), 150MW of battery energy storage systems (BESS), 50MW of electrolysis and 10MW of active consumption (AO).
