

What is a solar subsidy?

It is a one-off subsidy paid for by energy suppliers to help cover some of the costs of panel installation and is aimed at solar thermal panels, whether just to heat hot water or also for the central heating system. Photovoltaic panels are not eligible

How will a government subsidy affect solar panels?

The Central Government will provide substantive subsidies directly to people's bank accounts and heavily concessional bank loans to ensure that there is no cost burden on the people. The government subsidy will cover up to 40% of the cost of installation of the solar panels.

Who can access government solar panel subsidies?

Homeowners, businesses, and farmers can access government solar panel subsidies. To qualify, you typically need to own the property, meet certain income or energy usage criteria, etc. Farmers can benefit from schemes like PM-KUSUM, PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, etc.

How much is a 3 kW solar system subsidy?

The subsidy has been capped at 3 kW capacity. At current benchmark prices, this will mean Rs 30,000 subsidy for 1 kW system, Rs 60,000 for 2 kW systems and Rs 78,000 for 3 kW systems or higher. Who are eligible to apply for the Scheme? 1. The applicant must be an Indian citizen. 2.

How many households will get free electricity in 2024-25?
