Why does my computer shut down at 30%?

How to stop a computer from shutting down?

Scroll to button and click the +sign of the battery to expand settings. Now click on Critical battery level and change the setting to 35%. Click on critical battery action and change the setting to hibernate. This will hibernate your system by saving your entire session to continue on next start,hence preventing it from sudden shutdown.

Why is my battery not working?

That almost surely means your battery is failing and can't provide enough output. It's not your operating system performing the shutdown, it's just the voltage drops until it can't power the system. How long do laptop batteries last?
