

# The battery was changed but the system was not updated

Why can't I update my battery?

Many batteries that need firmware updates cannot be updated because they are out of charge, and cannot be charged because they are not updated. The solution to this is to plug the AC adapter in to the battery WHILE it is also plugged into the cortex, which should be plugged into a computer with the V5 Coding Studio installed.

Why is my laptop battery not charging after auto update?

Following an auto update, the laptop battery was not charging. I could solve the issue by a system restore. So, it looks that this is not due to a hardware problem. Before turning on auto update.... Since you already updated the BIOS then I suggest you update the Chipset and some of the other drivers as well.

How to reinstall battery after auto update?

After you turn on auto update and the battery is disabled again, you can try a few things out before going to the restore point you have created: 1. Check in Settings and make sure Airplane switch mode is turned off. 2. Uninstall /Reinstall battery in device manager. Dear all, I got a Dell Inspiron 13 7000 series laptop with Windows 10.

How do I fix a battery not charging after Windows Update?

Here's the solution that worked for me: go to Windows Update - Repair, and install the latest repair version available. The battery started charging immediately, even while the installation was still in progress. I am using update (KB5045991). Battery not charging. Stuck on 0%. I am using an ASUSTek laptop.

Why does my laptop not have a battery?

I have a laptop that does not contain a battery, it is always in a docking station which is connected to mains power. I've seen the battery charge level issue crop up a few times with drivers/firmware/Windows version updates. In this particular instance, it is an HP firmware update. Thank you for that information.

How to fix a battery problem on a Windows computer?

Recalibration of a battery can also help fix battery issues on a Windows computer. We suggest you recalibrate your battery and see if it works. You can perform a battery test. However, the chances of a malfunctioned battery are less because the battery has stopped charging after a Windows Update.

Unplug the power. Press and hold Power and Volume Up for at least 30 seconds. Plug power back in. Try to power up the device. Here's a work-around that saved my bacon.

Try go to Settings > Update & Security > Recovery. After installing the latest Windows update (KB5041587), my laptop no longer charges when plugged in. The battery level remains at 0%, and the charging icon is displayed, but the battery does not gain.

Here's a step-by-step guide to troubleshoot the situation. Power off the laptop completely. Disconnect the power adapter. Hold the power button down for 15-20 seconds to ...

If you did get a Low Battery warning for a sensor, then yes, that would be an actual low battery. You need to fix the charging problem before updating. If the system does not recognize the AC adapter, the battery won't charge. Check to make sure the AC adapter is listed on the setup screen with its power rating. If it's not -- in other words, it shows unknown -- the battery won't charge.
