

How do I calibrate my battery?

In UWP Dragon Center and Creator Center, go to the Tools tab, then click on the Battery Calibration icon to open the Window. In MSI Center for Business and Productivity, go to System Diagnosis in the Support tab, then click on the Battery Calibration icon to open the Window.

How do I calibrate my HP laptop battery?

Battery Calibration using HP Hardware Diagnostics: In the HP PC Hardware Diagnostics UEFI, select Component Tests. Select Power, then Battery to start the battery test. Follow the on-screen instructions to calibrate the battery. If this method still doesn't work, you can manually calibrate your battery using the following steps:

How do I calibrate my MSI battery?

Click on the Start menu, then look for Battery Calibration in the MSI folder. Before starting the calibration, please connect the adapter and do not remove it until Battery Calibration is done. Please also make sure that the battery is properly set in place, and there are no other applications running.

Battery Calibration is a built-in battery software. Calibrating the battery helps to reset the battery power setting. It can be done with a single click. In UWP Dragon Center and Creator Center, go to the Tools tab, then click on the Battery Calibration icon to open the Window.

How long should a laptop battery be calibrated?

You also need to calibrate the 6 flight mode buttons, they are actually treated as a slider in the radio. If your flight mode buttons are not working, chances are you haven't calibrated them yet.
