

Are old car batteries still available?

Old-style rubber-cased batteries are still available, the leaflets below illustrate the type of car batteries that would have been fitted to cars in the 1950s and 1960s. Anyone wanting to restore their car's underbonnet area to how it would have looked in that era, needs to look out for a period-correct battery like those shown below.

What is a classic car battery?

There are some differences in batteries that are for a classic car. All batteries are a variant of the lead acid battery that has been used for 100 years. There are design differences however. Wet cell (flooded), gel cell, and absorbed glass mat (AGM) are three variations.

How long does a classic car battery last?

A good battery should last three to four years, yet only about one out of three batteries will make it to year four. With most classic cars being stored more than they are driven, batteries tend to suffer more from not being used. As a matter of fact, batteries and electrical problems are one of the more common complications plaguing classic cars.

What was the first battery made in the United States?
